
1. Call to order and quorum call.

5. Consent agenda.

  - b. Minutes of city council meeting of Nov 13, 2014.
6. Item 8 from November 13, 2014 agenda. Request to consider and adopt the Chase Bank as the depository banking facility for the city of Sandy Oaks, Texas. The Chase Bank representative Joe Alvarado stated that all accounts were insured through FDIC for \$250,000. If exceeded we would be required to open another account to cover the excess. 7. Item 9 from November 13, 2014 agenda. As the information on cost to additionally advertise in the Wilson County News was delayed the period for all advertising for RFQs for a city attorney be started immediately upon approval. (Mayor Clement)
8. Update on status of Inter-local agreement with Bexar County. (Alderman Ball)
9. Discuss and adopt an ordinance to limit through traffic on Priest Rd. to vehicles of 5 tons or less. (Mayor Clement)
10. Review and consider credentials of temporary volunteer to the City Marshal position. (Alderman Ball)
11. Until the beginning of the new calendar year there will be no city council meetings unless there is an emergency. Request a motion to adjourn.
