### Call Before You Dig

Any type of digging requires a call. Building a deck? Planting a tree? Installing a fence or mailbox? 811 is the number you should call before you begin any project. Always call 811 before you start any digging project! You can help avoid injury, expense, embarrassment and a very inconvenient day without critical services like electricity, internet or phone.

### Update on Trash Cleanup

The bulk pick up in March created a health hazard in the City and an opportunity to further define guidelines and requirements for future scheduling. Letters have been mailed to 172 lot owners with violations as documented as of May 25, 2016 requiring clean up within 10 days. If not addressed by the lot owner, the City will arrange for the clean up, bill the lot owner, and if the owner does not pay the bill, a lien will be placed upon their property, per abatement procedures authorized in ordinance 2016-55.

### Burning

July 1, 2016

The burning of household trash or domestic waste materials is prohibited in the City by ordinance 2015-35. The burning of brush as defined by the same ordinance is allowed by using the approved International Fire Code, 307.4.

The location for open burning shall not be less than 50 feet from any structure, and provisions shall be made to prevent the fire from spreading to within 50 feet of any structure.

#### **Exceptions:**

- 1. Fires in approved containers that are not less than 15 feet from a structure.
- 2. The minimum required distance from a structure shall be 25 feet where the pile size is 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height.

An approved container is a burn barrel or other fire containment structure with a wire mesh screen used to prevent the spread of sparks and flames.

The City Marshal is appointed and is currently a volunteer position. The city has appointed Mr. Jesse Gutierrez, a resident of the city and a Licensed Peace Office with the City of Floresville. The role of the City Marshal will be to answer complaints, enforce ordinances, and keep the peace. Bexar County Sheriff's Office will continue to respond to calls within our city.

Per ordinance 2016-37, Section 4.A.4., it shall be unlawful to keep any animal defined as livestock (domesticated horses, cattle, goats, sheep or swine) in any of the residential areas within the City limits.

#### Coming Soon - The Shops at Sandy Oaks

The Shops at Sandy Oaks will be building at the intersection of Mathis Rd/New Mathis Rd. EDGE CON, a small business since 2007, is developing spaces for retail, business professional and medical. The current plan is to begin with 5 spaces @ 1250 sq ft and 4 spaces @ 1000 sq ft. and to expand to Phase II once the initial sites are leased. They will be equipped to run 1 sit down restaurant with a capacity of 50 as well as 3 spaces for fast food operations. EDGE CON is expecting to have the strip mall ready for occupancy by 2017. They also will have available 3 1-acre pad sites available for sale.

Elena Huerta of EDGE CON states "We not only live in the area, but our children go to school in the district. We love where we live and would like to see more economic growth and development in this area. We hope that by building the shops at Sandy Oaks we can bring more job opportunities closer to home as well as convenience to the community."
