ORDINANCE NO: 2015-14

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MASTER FEE SCHEDULE FOR REGULATING AND ASSESSING FEES; PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION OF FEES; REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT WITH THE MASTER FEE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; FIXING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Oaks finds a Master Fee Schedule shall provide a centralized means of providing the public information of all fees assessed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Oaks has determined that the public welfare would be best served by establishing a Master Fee Schedule.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: FEES

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. This ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be cumulative of all ordinances of the City of Sandy Oaks and this Ordinance shall not operate to repeal or affect any such other ordinance except insofar as the provisions thereof might be inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance, in which event such conflicting provision, if any, in such other ordinance or ordinances are hereby repealed.


Regulation in regard to enforcement of the fees herein is contained in the various instruments of legislation adopted by the City Council of Sandy Oaks.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, phrase, sentence or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distance than independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. PENALTIES. A person or company who commits a violation of any section or subsection of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than five-hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each violation. Each and every day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. That the City of Sandy Oaks City Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be published in every issue of the official newspaper for two days; or one issue of the newspaper if the official newspaper is a weekly paper. This ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders, and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect when the publication requirement is satisfied.
