

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-17

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS RETAINING KASSAHN & ORTIZ, P.C. TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES AS MUNICIPAL ATTORNEY (CITY ATTORNEY).**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas (the "City") adopted Ordinance 2014-3 which establishes the Office of Municipal Attorney (City Attorney) and provides the procedure for appointment, tenure, compensation, and duties of said officer; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City finds it necessary to appoint a City Attorney to provide legal advice to the Aldermen and Mayor in City-related matters; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council issued a request for applications for City Attorney and after review of qualified applications selected Kassahn & Ortiz, P.C. as City Attorney.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:**

**Section 1. Appointment of City Attorney.** The City Council for the City hereby selects Kassahn & Ortiz, P.C. to serve as City Attorney and provide legal services to the City for City-related matters.


**Section 2. Agreement for Legal Services.** The Agreement for Legal Services attached hereto as Exhibit A outlines the terms of the agreement between the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas and Kassahn & Ortiz, P.C. for legal services for City-related matters and is incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance for any reason is held invalid, illegal, or incapable of being enforced, such section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase shall be excluded to the extent of such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability; all other sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance.
