**ORDINANCE NO. 2015- 33**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS  
APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF ELMENDORF AND THE CITY OF SANDY  
OAKS REGARDING THE TRANSPORTATION OF DOGS,  
PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 791 of the Government Code, also known as the Interlocal Cooperation Act, authorizes local governments to contract with each other to provide a governmental function or service that each party to the contract is authorized to perform individually and in which the contracting parties are mutually interested, such as public health and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Oaks entered into an Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Sandy Oaks and the City of Selma Regarding the Holding and Disposal of Dogs (“Selma Interlocal Agreement”) pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Oaks requires services related to the transportation of stray, unrestrained, homeless, abandoned, or unwanted dogs to the City of Selma and is not equipped to render such services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elmendorf has represented it has the capabilities of transporting stray, unrestrained, homeless, abandoned, or unwanted dogs captured by the City of Sandy Oaks to the City of Selma for holding and disposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Oaks is authorized and desires to enter into a Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Elmendorf and the City of Sandy Oaks Regarding the Transportation of Dogs, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated by reference (“Elmendorf Interlocal Agreement”), for the purpose of transporting stray, unrestrained, homeless, abandoned, or unwanted dogs to the holding facility in the City of Selma pursuant to the Selma Interlocal Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Oaks and the City of Elmendorf have represented that each is independently authorized to perform the functions contemplated by the Elmendorf Interlocal Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Oaks has sufficient funds available from current revenues to perform the functions contemplated by the Elmendorf Interlocal Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council finds as true and correct and adopts the findings and recitals set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance.

**Section 2.** The City Council agrees to and approves the Elmendorf Interlocal Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" with the purpose of transporting stray, unrestrained, homeless, abandoned, or unwanted dogs to ~~the~~ City of Selma beginning December <sup>15<sup>th</sup></sup>, 2015 for a one-year term with the City of Elmendorf. The Mayor of the City is authorized to execute the Elmendorf Interlocal Agreement on behalf of the City.

**Section 3.** That the provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any part of this Ordinance will not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance.
