

**CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2017--78**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS RATIFYING THE PROPERTY TAX INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 102.007 of the Local Government Code provides in part that the adoption of a budget that will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year requires a separate vote of the governing body to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 102.007 of the Local Government Code requires that this ratification be in addition to and separate from the vote to adopt the budget or a vote to set the tax rate required by Chapter 26, Texas Tax Code, or other law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget, as adopted requires raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year, and the City Council desires by adoption of this Ordinance to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the City's Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Council, as the governing body of the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas, having adopted the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget by Ordinance No. 2017-77 that will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year, hereby ratifies the property tax reflected in the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget, which is the amount of \$6,398 and/or 0.026 percent and of that amount \$6,346 is tax revenue to be raised from new property tax added to the tax roll this year as reflected in the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Budget adopted on September 14, 2017.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the date after its passage.
