RESOLUTION 2019-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS DECLARING LACK OF CONFIDENCE IN CITY MARSHAL PURSUANT TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 22.077(B).

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas is a Type A general-law municipality incorporated and organized under the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2018-108 establishes the position of City Marshal; and

WHEREAS, Anthony Ibarra was sworn in as City Marshal on December 13, 2018; and

WHEREAS, section 22.077(b) of the Local Government Code provides the governing body of a Type A general-law municipality may remove a municipal officer at any time if the governing body lacks confidence in a municipal officer appointed by the governing body, provided that, two-thirds of the elected aldermen vote in favor of a resolution declaring the lack of confidence; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to remove the City Marshal declaring lack of confidence in the City Marshal pursuant to section 22.077(b) of the Local Government Code;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS INCORPORATED. The City Council finds the statements made in the preamble above are true and correct and incorporates them into the body of this Resolution as if fully stated herein.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF LACK OF CONFIDENCE. The City Council hereby declares a lack of confidence in the City Marshal, with four (4) of the elected aldermen voting in favor of this Resolution.


SECTION 3. REMOVAL OF CITY MARSHAL. The City Council hereby removes Anthony Ibarra as City Marshal pursuant to Local Government Code section 22.077(b).

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If for any reason any part of this Resolution is invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions of this Resolution shall remain in effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and approval of this Resolution.
