RESOLUTION NO. 2020-114

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A NATIONAL INCIDENT-BASED MANAGEMENT SYSTEM GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas ("City") finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City to apply for grant funds for the Texas conversion to the National Incident-Based Management System ("NIBMS") to begin in 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks approves the Office of the City Marshal's submission of the grant application for the NIBMS to the Office of the Governor.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks designates the Mayor as the City's authorized official. The Mayor is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the City.

Section 3. The City Council agrees to provide and budget applicable matching funds, if any, for any said project subject to the NIBMS grant as required by Homeland Security Grants Division grant application.


Section 4. The City agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full and take any action necessary to recover any funds lost or misused, if necessary.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution for any reason is held invalid, illegal, or incapable of being enforced, such section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase shall be excluded to the extent of such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability; all other sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and approval of this Resolution.


