

CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
February 25, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.


1. **Call to order and quorum call.** Mayor Ball called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. In attendance were Aldermen Fillinger, Bricken, Repino, Crickmer, and Puente, City Attorney Casandra Ortiz, and City Secretary Katherine Yelton.
2. **Mayor and Administrator Announcements/Updates.**
 - a) Updates related to weather – Mayor Ball indicated a lot of citizens have recovered from the winter freeze, but there are some citizens who are still in the process of getting water pipes replace/repared. She stated the Commissioners' Court approved an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00 to support a SAWS program for pipe repair reimbursement. There will be more information that will be shared as it is released. Mayor Ball mentioned the City Park had a major water line break at the public bathrooms, so they will be closed until everything is fixed.
 - b) Mayor Ball shared information from San Antonio Metro Health indicating a significant increase in COVID-19 cases in the city. December's report was 265 effected citizens and January's number is at 407 cases. She also mentioned that Uday with MedCare Pharmacy has begun getting vaccine doses in stock and he has started administering those doses.
3. **Citizens to be heard.** Mayor Ball read an email from Mr. Douglas Tomasini.
4. **Consent Agenda.** All matters listed under Consent Agenda are considered routine by the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks and will be enacted by one motion. There will not be separate discussion of these items. If discussion is desired, that item will be removed from the consent agenda and will be considered separately.
 - a) Approve the minutes from the February 11, 2021 Regular City Council Meeting. Mayor Ball pulled this item as the minutes were not yet ready for consideration.
6. **Marshal**
 - a) Updates and Announcements from Marshal Lopez with possible discussion and action. Marshal Lopez had no updates or announcements.
7. **Animal Control**
 - a) Updates and Announcements from Animal Control Advisory Committee ("ACAC") Chair Jennifer Puente with possible discussion and action. Alderman Puente had no updates or announcements.
8. **Public Works/Parks**
 - a) Update and Announcements from Park Advisory Committee Chair Tom Repino with possible discussion and action. Alderman Repino had no updates or announcements.
 - b) Updates and Announcements from Public Works Employee Priscilla Schmitt. PW employee Ms. Schmitt had no updates or announcements.
 - c) Discuss and/or possible action to approve the appointment of a nomination to serve on the Park Advisory Committee. Alderman Repino nominated Ashley Del Real to fill a spot on the advisory committee. Ms. Del Real accepted the nomination. Alderman Repino made a motion to approve the nomination, which was seconded by Alderman Crickmer and passed unanimously.
9. **Administration**
 - a) Discuss and/or possible action on quotes received on skirting new municipal building and approval of purchase. Alderman Fillinger made a motion to award the contract to Danny

Avila Remodeling for a cost not to exceed \$7,300.00, which was seconded by Alderman Repino and passed unanimously.

- b) Discuss and/or possible action on quotes received for movers for new municipal building and retain movers. Alderman Fillinger made a motion to award the contract to Eddie Pintor Full Service Moving for a cost not to exceed \$2,000.00, which was seconded by Alderman Repino and passed unanimously.
- c) Discuss and/or possible action quotes received for internet service for new municipal building and approve purchase of service. Alderman Repino made a motion to approve the internet service from Alamo Broadband for a recurring monthly cost of \$199 for up to 1gbps of service. This was seconded by Alderman Crickmer and passed unanimously.
- d) Discuss and/or possible action of approving an ordinance continuing or renewing the Mayor's declaration of Local State of Disaster due to severe winter weather emergency and other matters related thereto. Alderman Fillinger made a motion to approve the ordinance, which was seconded by Alderman Repino and passed unanimously.

10. Adjourn – The meeting adjourned at 7:26 p.m.
