## CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, March 16, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

- Call to Order. Mayor Fillinger called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Also present for the meeting were Mayor Pro Tem Fillinger, Alderman Repino, Bricken, Crickmer and Alderwoman Martinez. Intern Jacqueline Guerrero was also present.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance. Led by Mayor Fillinger.
- 3. Citizens to be heard. No one signed up to speak.
- 4. Discuss and/or possible action on removing Dalton Ellis from the Citizen Complaint Review Board ("CCRB") as a citizen representative. Mrs. Rabe holds the City Employee position on the Board. ACO Ellis was on the board as a citizen representative and is now an employee. ACO Ellis agreed to step down from the board. Alderman Repino made a motion to accept ACO Ellis's resignation. Seconded by Alderman Bricken.
- 5. Discuss and/or possible action on removing Joell Magny from the CCRB as the police representative and appointing Adrian Castillo to be the police representative. As Mr. Magny has resigned, Officer Castillo has agreed to fill the Police Officer position on the board. Mayor Pro Tem Martinez made a motion to approve Officer Castillo filling the vacancy left by Officer Magny. Seconded by Alderman Repino.
- 6. Discuss and/or possible action on removing Mayor Fillinger from the CCRB as the elected representative and appointing another elected official to the CCRB. Mayor Fillinger is removing himself from the Board as the elected official and Alderman Bricken volunteered to serve as the elected official. Alderman Repino made a motion to approve adding Alderman Bricken to the Board as the elected official.
- 7. Discuss and/or possible action on determining a time to accept citizen applications to serve on the Citizen Complaint Review Board and related matters. After a discussion, it was decided to receive applications for the CCRB from March 17<sup>th</sup> thru April 1 by 5:00 p.m. Mayor Pro Tem Martinez made a motion to approve these dates and to advertise on Nixle, NextDoor and our Website. Seconded by Alderman Repino. Motion passed unanimously.
- 8. Adjourn. Alderman Repino made a motion to adjourn at 6:48 p.m. Seconded by Alderwoman Martinez. Motion passed unanimously.
