RESOLUTION NO. 2022-163

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN TO SERVE AS CODE ENFORCEMENT VOLUNTEERS TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITY PURSUANT TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE § 21.003.

WHEREAS, section 21.003 of the Local Government Code allows for members of the governing body of a municipality to serve as a volunteer for an organization that protects the health, safety, or welfare of the municipality regardless of whether the organization is funded or supported in whole or part by the municipality if the governing body adopts a resolution allowing members of the governing body to perform service of that nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas (the "City") finds that code enforcement protects the health, safety and welfare of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2021-194, the City Council established the Code Enforcement Official with the authority to protect the life, health, property, safety and welfare of the public by executing the enforcement of city ordinances, state laws, and applicable codes under the supervision of the Chief of Police and other general duties as provided by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to allow its members, if they so choose, to volunteer to perform code enforcement duties to protect the health, safety or welfare of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. FINDINGS INCORPORATED. The findings set forth above are found to be true and correct and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION OF MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL TO VOLUNTEER TO PROVIDE CODE ENFORCEMENT. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and Aldermen to serve as a volunteer to perform code enforcement duties as provided for in Ordinance No. 2021-194, as amended, or state law, for the City of Sandy Oaks to protect the health, safety, or welfare of the City.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
