Essential Job Functions:

- Patrols public streets enforcing traffic laws and city ordinances, issuing warnings or citations, as required
- Detects violations
- Investigates circumstances and causes of accidents
- Prepares reports on activities and submits to supervisor
- Assists Animal Control Officer in capture and control of various domestic and wild animals
- Maintains equipment in proper working order
- Utilizes communication equipment effectively
- Secures crime and accident scenes
- Provides assistance and information to the public
- Reports traffic hazards to proper departments (i.e. traffic lights out, stop signs missing, etc.)
- Performs other duties as assigned
