**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-223**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS  
REPEALING ORDINANCE 2020-160 AND PROVIDING  
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks (“City”) adopted Ordinance No. 2020-160, which established a juvenile curfew pursuant to Local Government Code section 341.905; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2020-160 expired on the third anniversary of its adoption by the terms of the Ordinance and section 370.002 of the Local Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the 88<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature enacted House Bill 1819 prohibiting political subdivisions from adopting or enforcing an order, ordinance, or other measure that imposes a curfew to regulate the movements or actions of persons younger than 18 years of age, which will be codified as Local Government Code section 370.007, and repealing Local Government Code section 341.905, effective September 1, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that Ordinance 2020-160 should be repealed pursuant to HB 1819;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 2020-160.** Ordinance No. 2020-160 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


**SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance.
