## RESOLUTION NO: 2023-186

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS NAMING A PUBLIC NEWSPAPER TO SERVE AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS AND PROVIDING THAT EACH ORDINANCE, NOTICE, OR OTHER MATTER REQUIRED BY LAW OR ORDINANCE TO BE PUBLISHED THEREIN.**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 52.004 of the Texas Local Government Code, as soon as practicable after the beginning of each municipal year, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks is required to contract with a public newspaper to be the City's official newspaper for the purpose of publishing each ordinance, notice, or other matter required by law or ordinance to be published until another newspaper is selected: and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks, has determined that *Wilson County News* is a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks finds it advisable and prudent to contract with *Wilson County News* to be the official newspaper of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS that:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Resolution by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.


**Section 2.** The City Council hereby determines, in its discretion, that is advisable to enter into an agreement with *Wilson County News* to be the official newspaper of the City of Sandy Oaks until another newspaper is selected.


**Section 3.** The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to negotiate and execute such agreement as necessary.

**Section 4.** Each ordinance, notice, or other matter required by law or ordinance to be published shall be published in *Wilson County News*.

**Section 5.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
