RESOLUTION NO. 2024-193

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS APPOINTING DELMA DOYAL AS CITY SECRETARY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Oaks' City Secretary, Katherine Yelton, submitted her resignation with an effective date of February 9, 2024; and

WHEREAS, it was necessary for the City Council to appoint a City Secretary upon Secretary Yelton's resignation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council voted to offer Delma Doyal the position of City Secretary and desires to provide for the appointment by resolution of Delma Doyal as City Secretary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. Appointment of City Secretary. Delma Doyal is hereby appointed City Secretary of the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas with an effective date of April 2, 2024, and shall serve until such time as the City Council desires.

Section 2. Duties of City Secretary. The City Secretary shall have all powers and duties of the City Secretary as provided for in Ordinance No. 2020-175, as amended, and those powers and duties as conferred upon the City Secretary by State law or Council action.

Section 3. Compensation. Compensation of the City Secretary shall be determined by City Council from time to time.


Section 4. Repealer Clause. All resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Council hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

Section 6. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.


