**RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 202**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS APPROVING A HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, natural hazards in the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas (“City”) area historically have caused significant disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) require communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, FEMA requires that communities update hazard mitigation action plans every five years in order to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has assessed the community’s potential risks and hazards and is committed to planning for a sustainable community and reducing the long-term consequences of natural and man-caused hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bexar County Hazard Mitigation Plan attached as Exhibit “A” outlines a mitigation vision, goals and objectives; assesses risk from a range of hazards; and identifies risk reduction strategies and actions for hazards that threaten the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1. FINDINGS INCORPORATED.** The City Council finds the statements made in the preamble above are true and correct and incorporates them into the body of this Resolution as if fully stated herein.

**SECTION 2. APPROVAL OF PLAN.** The Bexar County Hazard Mitigation Plan (“Plan”) attached as Exhibit “A” and incorporated by reference is approved in its entirety.

**SECTION 3. PURSUIT OF FUNDING.** The City will pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated therein, and will, upon receipt of such funding or other necessary resources, seek to implement the actions contained in the mitigation strategies.

**SECTION 4. AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITY OF MAYOR.** The City vests with the Mayor the responsibility, authority, and means to inform all parties of this action, assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan will be reviewed at least annually, and that any needed adjustments will be presented to the City Council for consideration.


**SECTION 5. RESPONSIBILITY OF CITY.** The City agrees to take such other action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Plan and report on progress as required by FEMA and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM).

**SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution, and the City Council hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions despite invalidity or unconstitutionality.


**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
