RESOLUTION NO. 2025-223

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS ELECTING A MAYOR PRO TEM.

WHEREAS, section 22.037 of the Local Government Code provides at each new governing body's first meeting or as soon as practicable, the governing body shall elect one alderman to serve as the President Pro Tempore, also referred to as the Mayor Pro Tem, for a term of one year; and

WHEREAS, a new governing body of the City of Sandy Oaks held its first meeting on December 12, 2024 after a general and special election ordered by the City Council which was held on November 5, 2024 and canvassed on November 19, 2024;

WHEREAS, Alderwoman Grace Alvarado was elected Mayor Pro Tem by Resolution No. 2024-250 to serve for a term of one year or until her successor is elected; and

WHEREAS, Alderwoman Alvarado submitted her written and signed resignation to the Mayor on March 21, 2025 from the positions of Alderman Place 4 and Mayor Pro Tem which was accepted by the City Council at its regular meeting on March 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to elect a Mayor Pro Tem for the remainder of the one year term or until his or her successor is elected;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. ELECTION OF MAYOR PRO TEM. The City Council hereby elects Monica Madero to serve as Mayor Pro Tem for the remainder of the one year term or until his or her successor is elected.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY OF MAYOR PRO TEM. If the Mayor fails, is unable, or refuses to act, the Mayor Pro Tem shall perform the Mayor's duties and is entitled to receive any fees and compensation prescribed for the Mayor.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.
