ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 254

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS CREATING A PARKS ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2019-136.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks ("City") adopted Ordinance No. 2019-136 creating a Parks Committee to act in an advisory capacity to the City Council on the operation of City parks and recreational activities and solicit funds and donations for the maintenance and operation of City parks and recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City desires to repeal ordinance No. 2019-136 and adopt this Ordinance creating a Parks Advisory Committee and establish the purpose, membership, terms, compensation, procedures and quorum of the Parks Advisory Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:

- Section 1. The City Council hereby creates a Parks Advisory Committee to act in an advisory capacity to the City Council on the operation of City parks and recreational activities and solicit funds and donations for the maintenance and operation of City parks and recreational activities. The Parks Advisory Committee shall advise the City Council on the adoption of rules and regulations necessary to plan, promote, supervise and regulate all recreational activities to be offered by the City and recommend uses and purchases for City parks and recreational activities.
- **Section 2.** The Parks Advisory Committee shall consist of a minimum of 5 members nominated by the Mayor or an Alderman and nomination confirmed by the City Council. The City Council shall appoint a member from the City Council to serve as the Chair of the Parks Advisory Committee. The City Council shall appoint a Co-Chair among the members of the Parks Advisory Committee. Members of the Park Advisory Committee serve at the pleasure of the Council and shall receive no compensation, except expenses, unless otherwise provided by ordinance. Members of the Park Advisory Committee serve until they resign or are removed by Council. A member who has three consecutive unexcused absences shall be removed automatically.
- **Section 3.** The Chair or his designee of the Parks Advisory Committee shall provide a report to the City Council at its first regular monthly meeting when necessary.
- **Section 4.** A majority of the Parks Advisory Committee members shall constitute a quorum for the purposes of conducting a meeting.
 - Section 5. The City Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 2019-136.
- Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.
