RESOLUTION NO. 2026-239

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS FILLING A VACANCY ON THE CITY COUNCIL FOR ALDERMAN PLACE 3 (UNEXPIRED TERM) BY APPOINTMENT UNTIL THE NEXT REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas ("City") is a Type A municipality with an Aldermanic form of government pursuant to Chapter 22 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, Alderman Tom Repino was certified elected at a General Election held on November 4, 2025 as Alderman for Place 3 for a two-year term; and

WHEREAS, Alderman Repino sadly passed away on December 6, 2025 and pursuant to section 201.022 of the Election Code, if an officer or officer-elect dies, a vacancy occurs on the date of death; and

WHEREAS, section 22.010 of the Local Government Code provides if for any reason a single vacancy exists on the governing body of the municipality, a majority of the remaining members, excluding the mayor, may fill the vacancy by appointment unless an election to fill the vacancy is required by Article XI, Section 11, of the Texas Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds an election to fill the vacancy is not required by Article XI, Section 11, of the Texas Constitution and desires to fill the vacancy in the position of Alderman Place 3 by appointment until the next regular municipal election;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT. The above recitals are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.


SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT OF ALDERMAN PLACE 3. The City Council appoints Lamar McNeal to fill the office of Alderman Place 3 (unexpired term) until the next regular municipal election pursuant to Local Government Code Section 22.010(b).

SECTION 3. EXPRESSION BY CITY COUNCIL. The Mayor and City Council express their deepest gratitude for Alderman Repino's many years of dedicated service to the City of Sandy Oaks and the community and extends its heartfelt condolences to his family, friends, and loved ones.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and approval of this Resolution.


