ORDINANCE NO. 2026-268

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS
REPEALING ORDINANCE 2022-201 REGARDING
POSITIONS AND CLASSIFICATIONS WITHIN THE
POLICE DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks ("City") adopted Ordinance No. 2022-201 establishing positions and classifications of the Sandy Oaks Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council subsequently adopted Ordinance No. 2022-217, establishing the Sandy Oaks Police Department and authorizing the Chief of Police to establish the positions of Lieutenant, Sergeant, and Corporal, as permitted by the City Council, and fill those positions as permitted by the fiscal budget of the City, appointment subject to final approval of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds Ordinance No. 2022-201 is unnecessary, as Ordinance No. 2022-217 authorizes the Chief of Police to establish and fill such positions as provided by Ordinance No. 2022-217, and desires to repeal Ordinance 2022-201 for the benefit, health and safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT. The City Council finds the preambles set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 2022-201. Ordinance No. 2022-201 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance.
