RESOLUTION 2026-248

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to- moderate income; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Sandy Oaks to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:

1 That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the Community Development Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City of Sandy Oaks with the Texas Department of Agriculture.

2 That the application be for up to \$590,400.00 of grant funds to repair, replace and provide improvements to the Restless Deer Street Reconstruction Project including, but not limited to, street excavation, flexible base installation, hot mix asphaltic pavement placement, removal and replacement of concrete driveways, installation of concrete curb headers, mailbox removal and replacement, furnishing and placing topsoil, block sodding, adjustment of sewer manholes or water valves, and culvert pipe installation. The overall objective of the project is to improve the street infrastructure to enhance safety and accessibility for residents.

3 That the City Council directs and designates the following to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program:

- The Mayor shall serve as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to execute this application and any subsequent contractual documents or may designate an authorized representative of the City to act on his behalf;
- The Mayor is authorized to execute environmental review documents between the Texas Department of Agriculture and the City; and
- If this application is funded, the Mayor is authorized to execute the Request for Payment Form documents and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project


costs.

4. The City will comply with all program requirements.

5. That it further be stated that the City of Sandy Oaks is committing 10% of the grant request up to \$65,000.00 from its general fund as a cash contribution toward the construction activities to repair, replace and provide improvements to the Restless Deer Street Reconstruction project.


