**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-251**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS APPROVING PARK SIGNAGE FOR TOM REPINO PARK, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH WESTERN WELDING FOR THE DESIGN, FABRICATION, AND INSTALLATION OF A PARK SIGN, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Oaks Parks Advisory Committee (“Committee”) was created to act in an advisory capacity to the City Council on the operation of City parks and recreational activities and solicit funds and donations for the maintenance and operation of City parks and recreational activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee has met to discuss signage identifying the Tom Repino Park (the “Park”) and recommends the installation of signage at the entry of the Park in the design attached hereto in Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, Alderman Crickmer, Chair of the Committee, has discussed the design, fabrication, and installation of an entry sign with Western Welding (the “Contractor”) for an amount not to exceed \$6,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Western Welding (the “Contractor”) approving the design and for the fabrication and installation of an entry park sign as more particularly described in Exhibit A;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT.** The above recitals contained in the preamble herein are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks for all purposes, are adopted as a part of the judgement and findings of the City Council, and are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

**SECTION 2. APPROVAL OF DESIGN, AGREEMENT, AND AUTHORIZATION.** The City Council hereby approves the design for the park sign for the entrance of the Park as shown in Exhibit A and approves the Agreement for Services with the Contractor for fabrication and installation of the sign in substantially the same form as included in the attachment to Exhibit A (the “Agreement”). The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute and the City Parks Advisory Committee Chair to manage the Agreement attached as Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference, on behalf of the City, and oversee completion of the installation of the park sign as described in the Agreement.

**SECTION 3. REPEALER.** All resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

**SECTION 4. INTERPRETING LAW.** This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.


**SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Council hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

**SECTION 6. OPEN MEETINGS.** It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.


**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution takes effect upon final passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks.
